At Age Up Health we are dedicated to ensuring the health and safety of all our employees and clients. Healthcare workers may be exposed to, and transmit, vaccine-preventable diseases such as influenza, measles, rubella and pertussis. Maintaining immunity in the healthcare worker population helps prevent transmission of vaccine-preventable diseases to and from healthcare workers and clients.

Vaccine preventable diseases

According to the Australian Government Guidelines and Australian Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases all adults should be up to date with routinely recommended vaccines. These vaccines include diphtheria-tetanus containing vaccines, poliomyelitis vaccine and measles-mumps-rubella vaccines.
